



ANF STATISTICS For the Year 2013

ANF Accomplishments:

ANF brings opportunities to the poorest sectors in Nicaragua through education, housing and communities, health care and economic self-sufficiency programs. Since its founding, it has:

- Shipped more than 5,760 40-foot ocean containers of aid valued at over \$1.589 billion to Nicaragua
- Distributed 1,200 containers worth of medicine, medical supplies, and hospital/clinic equipment. Approximately 5 million medical consultations have been provided by an average of 150 centers supported by ANF
- Distributed over 900 containers valued at US\$94 million of school supplies
- Distributed over 2,000 containers valued at US\$71 million of food
- More than 1,500 containers of household goods including furniture, clothing, shoes, building materials, hygienic products, and others were distributed through ANF's network, benefiting elderly and children homes, clinics, schools, nutrition centers and others
- Served 239 million plates of nutritious food to children, mothers, and the elderly
- Supported the construction of over 16,500 homes for underprivileged, low-income families, benefiting 85,000 people
- More than 40,000 people have benefited from over 6,600 sanitary solutions
- Provided access to clean drinking water to more than 78,000 people through the construction of 46 water systems, 1,682 domiciliary connections and 88 water wells
- ANF has created access to self-sustainable jobs by providing the necessary tools and training, which has helped more than 3,300 families in husbandry and agricultural programs, who lived with less than \$2/day to more than double their income
- ANF has supported the construction of 96 classrooms, 43 community centers, 11 children dining halls, 10 medical clinics, 7 computer laboratories.

ANF in 2013:

- ANF works with a network of over a thousand governmental, religious, private and non-profit entities to ensure the delivery of donations to the most vulnerable population of Nicaragua
- In 2013, the in-kind distribution and project donations amounted to US\$112,657,000
- ANF distributed the contents of 383 40-foot ocean containers

Meals at Schools and Centers of Social Services/Attention:

- Shipped 149 containers of food valued at US\$6.9 million.
- Provided a daily hot meal to 550 centers benefiting more than 96,500 persons. The centers included schools, elderly homes, children homes, and rehabilitation centers.

Education:

- Provided 26 ocean containers of school supplies to 75,000 students in 228 centers
- Distributed more than 11,000 pieces of school furniture in 350 schools



- Under the Food for Education program and MannaPack, 80,000 students in 550 schools received a daily meal
- In conjunction with ANF's Sustainable Development Program, 16 classrooms were built

Health:

- Distributed 70 40-ft containers valued at US\$51.4 million of medicines, medical equipment, and reposition materials
- Distributed medicines, medical equipment, wheelchairs and other medical supplies through a network of 148 centers, including 27 hospitals. These 148 centers provided more than 220,000 consultations in 2013
- 80% of medicines distributed by ANF were for the treatment of chronic diseases
- 1,378 disabled individuals received wheelchairs, walkers, canes, and auxiliary equipment for improving mobility and quality of life
- Provided 25,000 rations of milk and food supplements, and 13,000 rations of cereal to 500 malnourished children in 4 nutritional recovery centers
- 48,000 school children participated in a health campaign learning about healthy lifestyles, focusing mainly on the importance of washing their hands as a means to prevent diseases
- Distributed deworming tablets to 500 schools, servicing 70,000 students. Tablets were also provided to teachers, administrative personnel, and school cafeteria personnel

Sustainable Development:

35,974 beneficiaries of ANF's Sustainable Development Program through the Community and Economic Development projects, including:

- 1,011 families received a dignified home
- 100 families received fruits and ornamental trees
- 1,335 sanitary solutions
- 1,156 clean water solutions
- 15 communal wells
- 13 classrooms
- 13 community centers
- 2 medical clinics
- 2 children feeding centers

ANF also supported the construction and planting of:

- 634 hectares, 140 Ha in 2013, of certified, registered and bean seeds for consumption
- 11 Ha of guava and papaya
- 5 additional greenhouses for growing vegetables
