



ANF FACTS For the Year 2014

ANF Accomplishments:

ANF brings opportunities to the poorest sectors in Nicaragua through education, housing and communities, health care and economic self-sufficiency programs. Since its registration as a 501(c)3, ANF has:

- Shipped more than 6,139 40-foot ocean containers of aid valued at over \$1.671 billion to Nicaragua
- Supplying over 1,277 containers, valued at \$1.279 billion of medicine, periodic replacement material, medical equipment and furnishings to 150 medical centers: These donations have strengthened the work of the centers which provide 250,000 consultations per year
- Distributed over 978 containers valued at US\$98 million of school supplies to Nicaraguan students
- Distributed over 2,181 containers of basic food valued at US \$ 77.67 million, equivalent to 258 million meals of nutritious food for children, mothers and elderly
- Over 1,700 containers of household goods, valued at \$215 million, including furniture, clothing, shoes, building materials, hygienic products, and others were distributed through ANF's network, benefiting elderly and children homes, clinics, schools, nutrition centers and others
- Supported the construction of over 17,242 homes for underprivileged, low-income families, benefiting 106,900 people
- More than 40,000 people have benefited from over 7,048 sanitary solutions
- Provided access to clean drinking water to more than 81,000 people through the construction of 1,728 water systems and domiciliary connections and 103 water wells
- ANF has created access to self-sustainable jobs by providing the necessary tools and training, which has helped more than 3,638 families in husbandry and agricultural programs, who lived with less than \$2/day to more than double their income
- ANF has supported the construction of 109 schools and classrooms, 52 community centers, 11 children dining halls, 10 medical clinics, 7 computer laboratories.

ANF in 2014

- ANF works with a network of over a thousand governmental, religious, private and non-profit entities to ensure the delivery of donations to the most vulnerable population of Nicaragua
- In 2014, the in-kind distribution amounted to US\$81.7 million
- ANF distributed the contents of 378 40-foot ocean containers
- ANF allocated \$3,775,084 to sustainable projects

ANF's administrative and fundraising expenses represent less than 2% of total expenses. **We are proud that over 98% of all donations go directly to programs that help those in need.**

Meals at Schools and Centers of Social Services/Attention:

- ANF distributed 136 containers of basic food valued at US\$6.5 million. Hot meals were provided to elementary schools, children homes, elderly homes, nutritional centers and rehabilitation centers daily to approximately 96,500 people.



Education:

- Provided 36 ocean containers of school supplies valued at \$4.1 million
- Provided school supplies to 75,000 students in 583 education centers
- Distributed 8,000 pieces of school furniture to 12,000 students in 131 schools

Health:

- In 2014, ANF distributed 78 40-ft containers valued at US\$57.7 million of medicines, medical equipment, and reposition materials
- Distributed medicines, medical equipment, wheelchairs and other medical supplies through a network of 130 centers, including 27 hospitals. These centers provided more than 250,000 consultations in 2014
- Provided training in handling of medicine, including a manual, to dispensaries that receive medical products from ANF
- More than a thousand disabled individuals received wheelchairs, walkers, canes, and auxiliary equipment for improving mobility and quality of life
- Provided milk, food supplements, and cereal to 500 malnourished children in 4 nutritional recovery centers
- Developed health campaign learning about healthy lifestyles, focusing mainly on the importance of washing their hands and hygiene as a means to prevent diseases
- Distributed deworming tablets to 66,500 students in 759 schools.

Sustainable Development:

ANF accomplishments under the Sustainable Development Program for 2014 include:

- 830 families received a dignified home
- 20 families received solar panels
- 130 families received fruits and ornamental trees
- 106 families received training, supplies and animals for poultry raising
- 30 families received training, supplies and animals for pelibuey raising
- 30 beekeepers received training, supplies and infrastructure for apiculture

ANF also contributed to the construction of

- 15 communal wells
- 13 classrooms
- 9 community centers

In addition, ANF made infrastructural improvements in 26 schools, such as school rooms, sleeping quarters, kitchen, bathrooms, water tanks, etc.

ANF also supported the planting of:

- 527 hectares of certified and registered bean seeds
- 6 hectares of guava and papaya
- 9 greenhouses for growing vegetables
